What Does Biblical Leadership Look Like?

Big Idea:

Elders lead by exercising oversight. (1 Pet 5:2)

Big Idea:

Elders lead willingly, not under compulsion. (1 Pet 5:2)

Big Idea:

Elders lead eagerly, not for shameful gain. (1 Pet 5:2)

Big Idea:

Elders lead by example, not oppressively. (1 Pet 5:3)

Big Idea:

Elders lead looking to Jesus. (1 Pet 5:4)

How Should God's People Respond To Elder Leadership?

Big Idea:

God's flock should be marked by submission. (1 Pet 5:5)

Obey your leaders and submit to them, for they are keeping watch over your souls, as those who will have to give an account. Let them do this with joy and not with groaning, for that would be of no advantage to you. Hebrews 13:17

Big Idea:

God's flock should be marked by humility. (1 Pet 5:5)

Clothe yourselves, all of you, with humility toward one another, for "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble."

1 Peter 5:1-5
